

I know numbers till 200 now. Can you help me to count numbers more than 200? It's very easy, Aman. I will help you to count numbers beyond 200 using blocks of hundreds, tens and ones.





Similarly, 3 hundreds + 9 tens + 4 ones = 394

7 hundreds + 2 tens + 9 ones = 729

Number Names

We already know how to write the number name of 3-digit numbers up to 200. We always write the hundreds place first, then the tens and ones places together. Let's see how to write number name of numbers more than 200.

213 is written as two hundred thirteen.

394 is written as three hundred ninety-four.


