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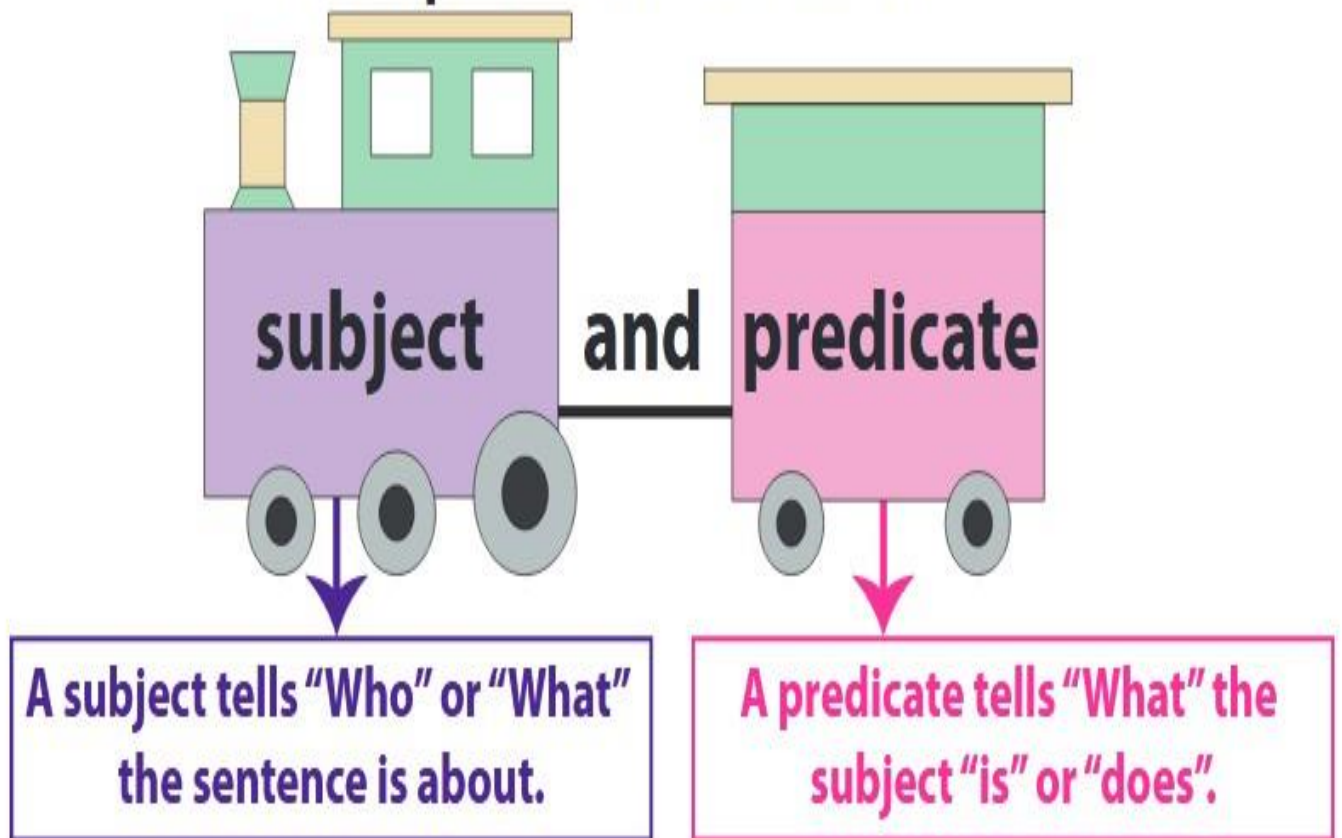

TOPIC: SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

A sentence can be divided into 2 parts, the Subject and the Predicate.

A complete sentence needs a...



Examples:

I

want a new car.

The umbrella

is blue.

They

ate pizza for dinner.

- In the first example, I want a new car, 'I' is the subject and 'want a new car' is the predicate.
 - The sentence speaks about 'I', hence, it is the Subject.
 - What the subject speaks about in the sentence, 'want a new car', hence this is the Predicate.

- Similarly, in the second example, 'the umbrella' is the subject and 'is blue' the predicate.

- 'They' is the subject and 'ate pizza for dinner' is the predicate in the third example.

- ❖ Subject is always a noun or pronoun.
- ❖ Predicate contains the verb.

Additional Examples

Subject	Predicate
The big green frog	jumped across the log.
My sweet grandmother	wore a blue dress.
The old shack	blew over in the wind.
My dog Barney	barked at the cat.
