Subject – Environmental Studies

Unit – 1 Super Senses

➤ Smell as a super sense in some animals.

In our previous class we observed that ants move in a straight line. So, today we are going to learn how they do it.



➤ Ants move in a line

As the ants move, they leave a smell on the ground. The other ants follow the smell to find the way.

➤ Some insects can find their female by their smell.



➤ Dogs mark out their own area



Super Senses

- *Have you seen a dog sniffing here and there? What do you think it is trying to smell?*
- *They can make out if another dog has come into their area by the smell of its urine or potty (latrine).*
- *They mark their own area by urinating around.*

➤ Wherever you go Mosquitoes can find you

- *Mosquitoes can find you by the smell of your body.*
- *They also find you by the smell of the sole of your feet and the heat of your body.*

Subject – Mathematics

Unitary System

Till now we have learnt:

1. If the value of 1 unit is given then how we can find the value of required unit.

For eg.

Value or cost of 1 pen is Rs 3

Then,

Cost of 5 such pens = $3 \times 5 = 15$.

One to many

2. If the value of more than one unit is given then how we can find the value of 1 unit.

For eg.

Value or cost of 5 pens is Rs 15

Then,

Cost of 1 pen = $15 \div 5 = \text{Rs } 3$.

Many to one

But some time we face problems like....

- If the cost of 6 eraser is 30 then what will be the cost of 35 such eraser.

In such cases we need to follow the following steps :

Step - 1(many to one)

Cost of 6 eraser is 30

Therefore, cost of 1 eraser – $30 \div 6 = 5$

Step - 2(one to many)

Cost of 1 eraser is Rs 5

Then,

Cost of 35 eraser = $35 \times 5 = 175$ rupees.
