Exclamatory Sentence

Read the following sentences:





The sentences given above express strong feelings of joy (sentence 1) and sadness (sentence 2). They are **Exclamatory Sentences**.

An exclamatory sentence is a short sentence that express strong emotions like joy, excitement, sorrow, pride, etc.

It ends with an exclamation mark (!).

Exclamatory sentences often begin with words like what or how.

Examples: 1. How beautiful she looks!

2. What a lovely purse!

Quick Revision:

- A Declarative sentence is a statement and ends with a full Stop (.).
- An Interrogative sentence is a question and ends with a question mark (?).
- An Imperative sentence gives order, advice or makes a request. It ends with a full stop (.).

2) Human Environment:

- ➤ Human beings interact with the environment and modify it according to their needs.
- > Early humans adapted themselves to their natural surroundings.
- ➤ With time, humans learnt to grow new things, domesticate animals and lead a settled life.
- > The industrial revolution, transportation and information revolution made communication easier and speedy across the world.

3) Human-made Environment:

- > Human-made environment refers to the human-made surroundings that provide facilities for human needs.
- > It comprises of buildings, parks, monuments, bridges, roads, industries etc. man has made over the time to meet their day-to-day requirements.
- **Ecosystem:** An ecosystem is formed by the interactions between all living and non-living things.

Examples -

- i) Forest ecosystem includes grass, soil, wind, sunlight, animals.
- ii) Ocean ecosystem includes fish, coral, rocks at the bottom, temperature of water.

* Barter System: A trade in which goods are exchanged without the use of money. For example, Ram has storage of oranges and Sana has storage of bananas. They can exchange 2 kg of each to each other without any use of money.
