

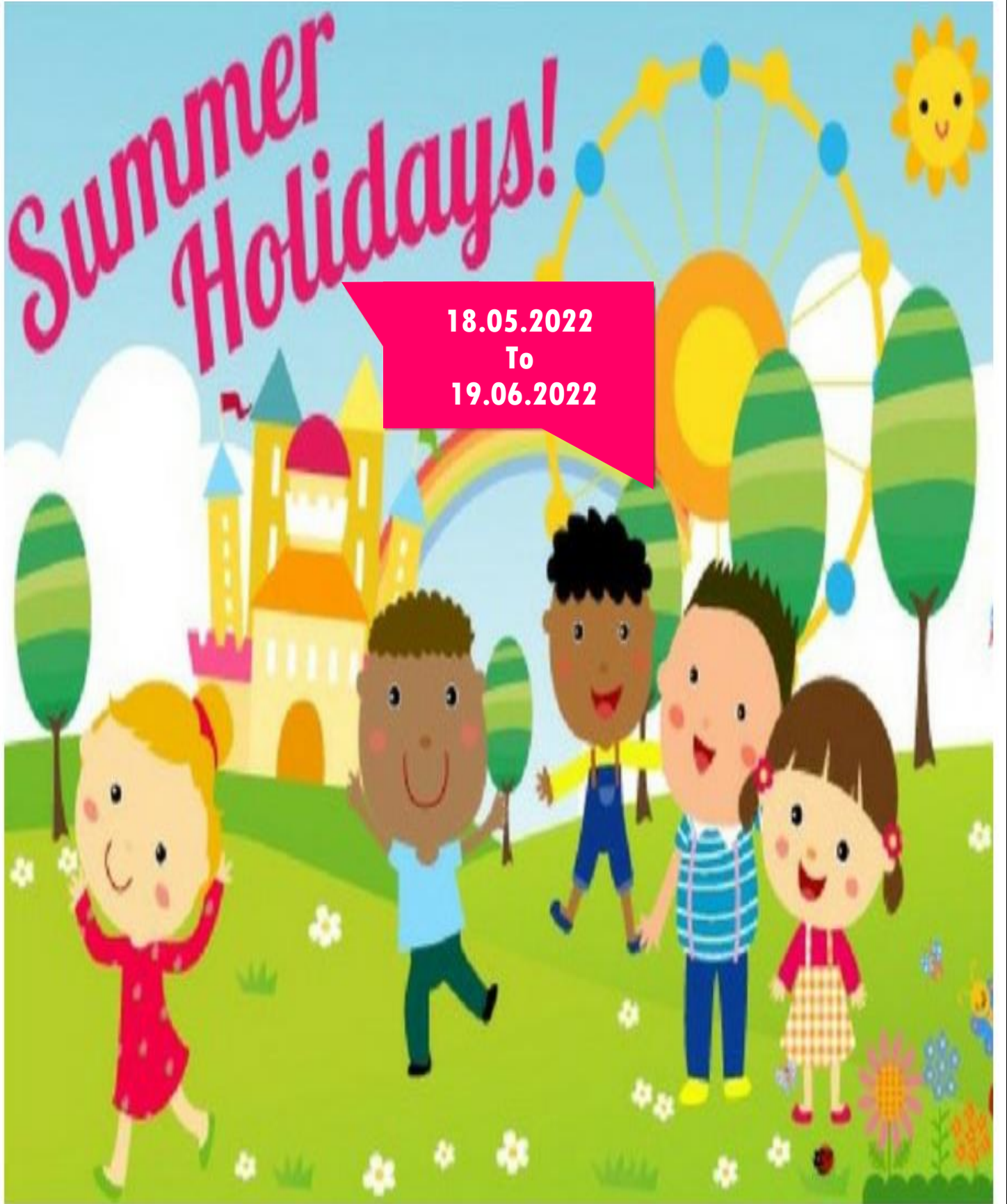


Dear Parents,

English	<p>a. On a chart paper, draw or paste the pictures of any 6 musical instrument players with their instruments and write a paragraph each about their contribution to music.</p> <p>b. English Language and Literature - Complete Assignments- 3 and 4 on pages 6 to 9 in the book.</p> <p>c. Complete the Writing task provided on page 29 (Beehive) in your English notebook.</p>
Maths	<p>a. Make model on ‘Types of Numbers’ as discussed in class.</p> <p>b. Revise chapter 1 to chapter 4 in notebook.</p>
Social Studies	<p>a. Collect information about any 2 projects launched to protect any two specific animal species and prepare a report on an A-3 sheet or a chart paper.</p> <p>b. Make a project on topic -Resources.</p> <p>Important notes: 1. Cover page, preface, table of contents, acknowledgements, bibliography, headings, and sub – headings and teacher's evaluation report are a must. 2. In the cover page, write school’s name, your name, section and the subject clearly. 3. The project should be presented in a file. 4. The project should not exceed 15 - 20 pages. 5.
