

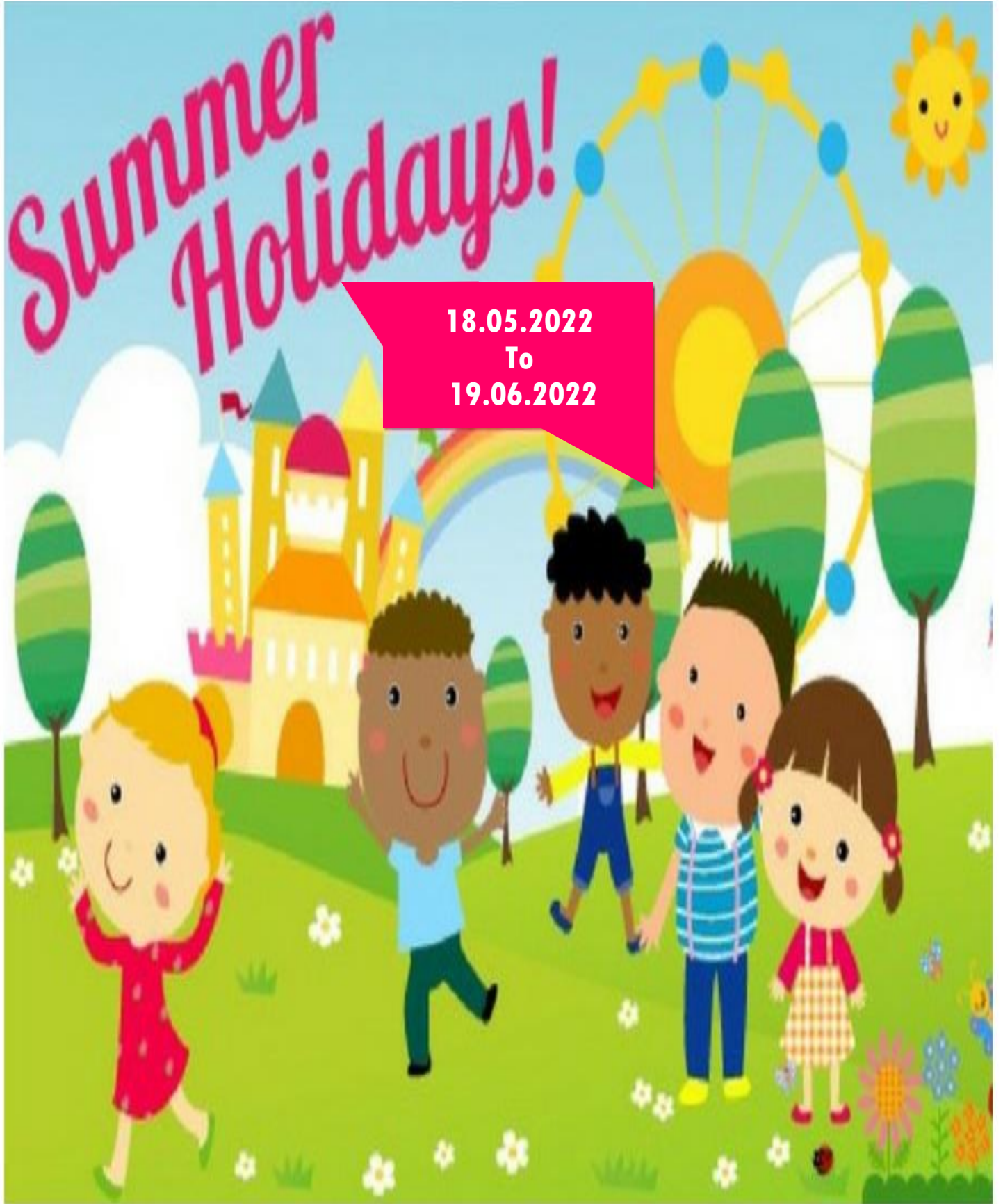


Dear Parents,
